

ABOUT THE PROJECT: BRIDGING CULTURAL HERITAGE WITH MODERN SKILLS

The "On the p@ths of culinary traditions" project brings participants closer to their cultural roots through traditional foods and culinary exchanges with international partners. Participants will have the opportunity to learn about global culinary traditions, enhancing their cooking skills while breaking down cultural stereotypes and building cross-cultural connections.

One key goal of this project is to improve participants' ICT skills, introducing them to tools like presentation creation, video production, and website development. The project also includes training on the use of technology in everyday life, work, and entrepreneurship, aiming to increase digital literacy among adult learners.

Project Aims and Expected Outcomes

Participants will not only enhance their digital skills but will also develop as engaged citizens, ready to take an active role in society and the workforce. By fostering entrepreneurial skills, the project supports the growth of local communities and boosts participants' employability.

The project involves a range of local and international activities, including:

Local Meetings with association members and stakeholders for experience-sharing and promoting project outcomes

Workshops and Webinars on ICT skills and culinary topics, engaging participants in practical learning

International Online Seminar to wrap up the project and highlight key insights

Three international training sessions (Learning, Teaching, Training Activities) are planned, offering participants a platform to share experiences, knowledge, and skills that will greatly contribute to their personal and professional growth.
